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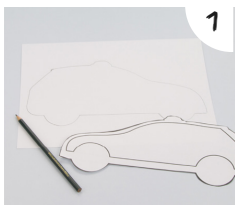
Woven Police Car

Supplies

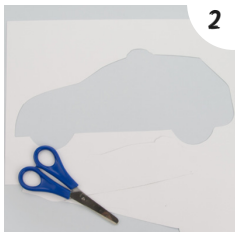
- Police car template
- Strips of blue and yellow card, 2cm wide
- A4 sized coloured card
- A4 paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Ribbon



– Hole punch



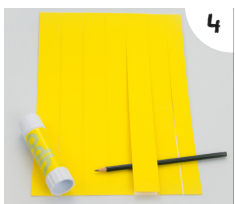
1 Draw around the police car template onto coloured card.



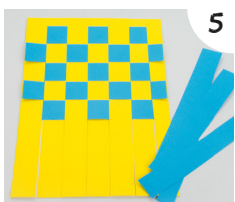
2 Cut the car shape out of the middle of the card, without damaging the outer rim. This should leave you with an A4 frame of card with a car shape cut out of it.



3 Cut strips of yellow and blue card into two sets; blue long enough for the width of the card and yellow long enough for the length of the card.



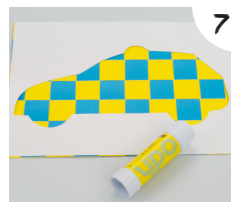
4 Place the yellow strips of card vertically onto the A4 paper. Glue them down at one end only.



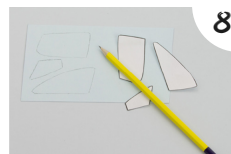
5 Weave the blue strips of card over and under the yellow strips of card.



6 Once the A4 paper is completely covered, glue all the edges of the woven card down. Then trim the excess card off to be flush with the A4 sheet.



7 Take the card car frame and spread glue onto one side of it. Then stick this down on top of the woven sheet.



8 Use the window templates to draw windows onto a grey or light blue card.



9 Cut out and stick on top of your weaving to give your car windows you could also make some wheels out of black card!



10 Finally, make a couple of holes at the top of the car frame using a hole punch.



11 Thread a loop of ribbon through to hang the woven paper police car from.

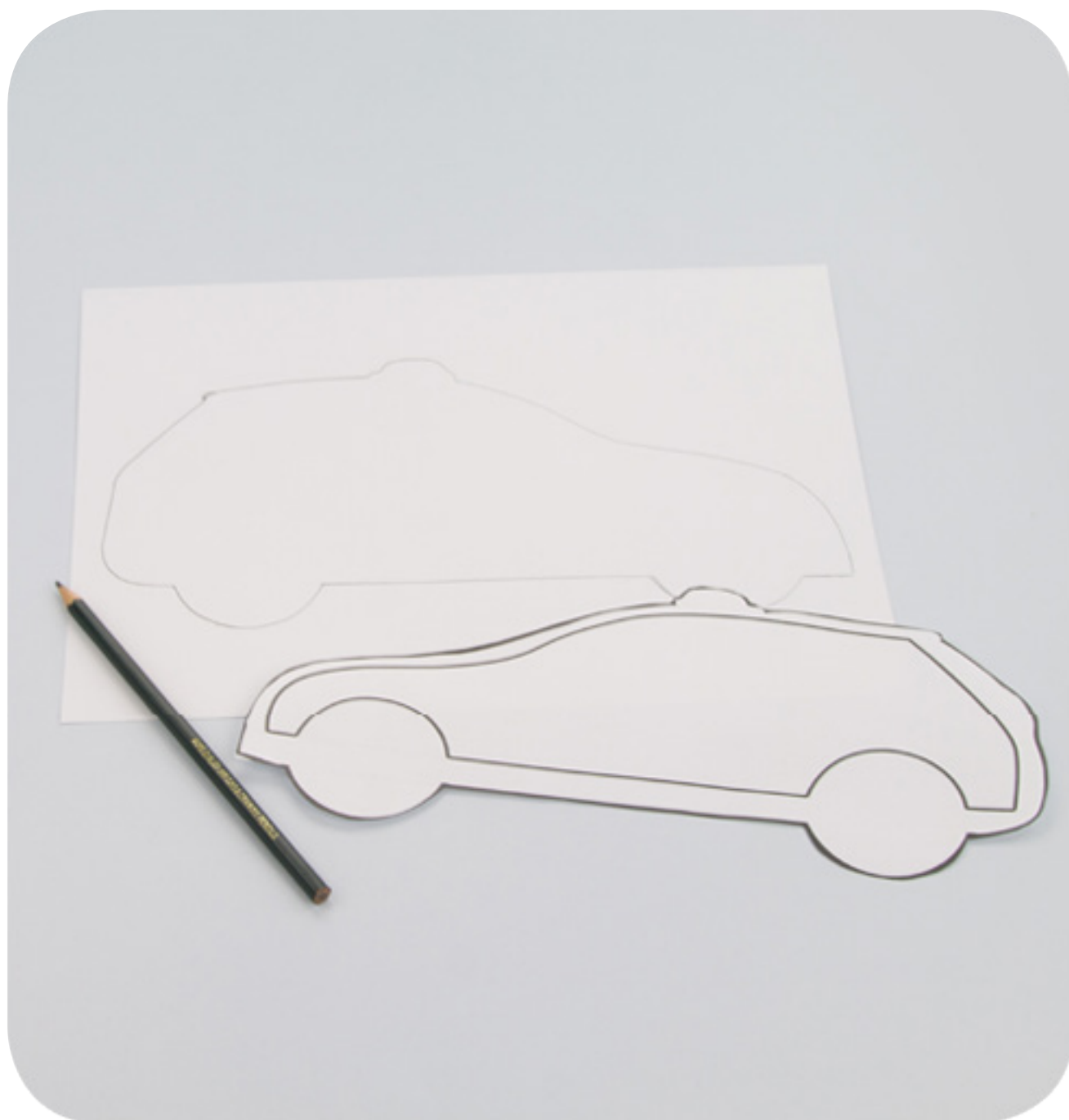
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Step 1. Draw around the police car template onto coloured card.

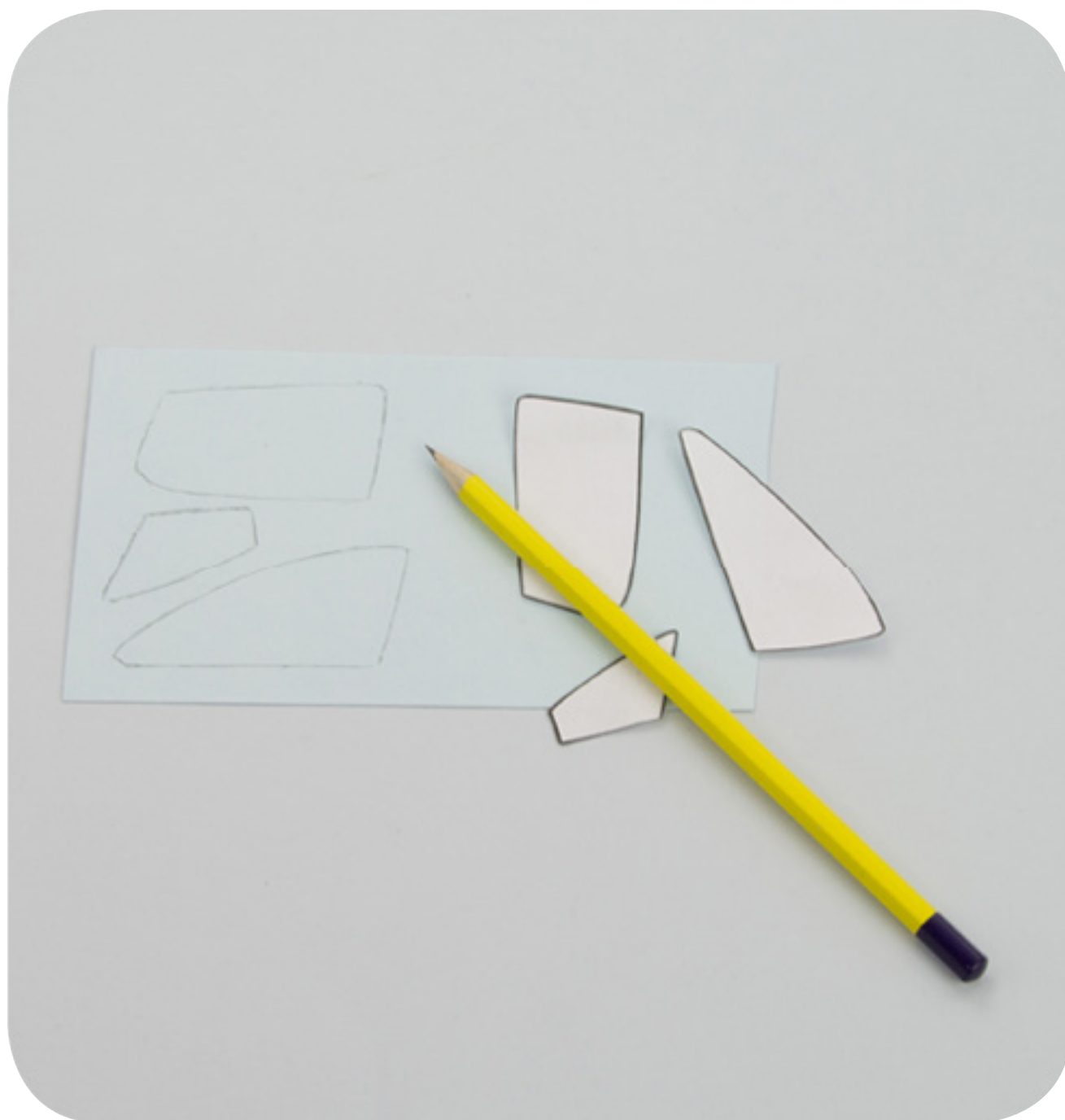
Step 5. Weave the blue strips of card over and under the yellow strips of card.
