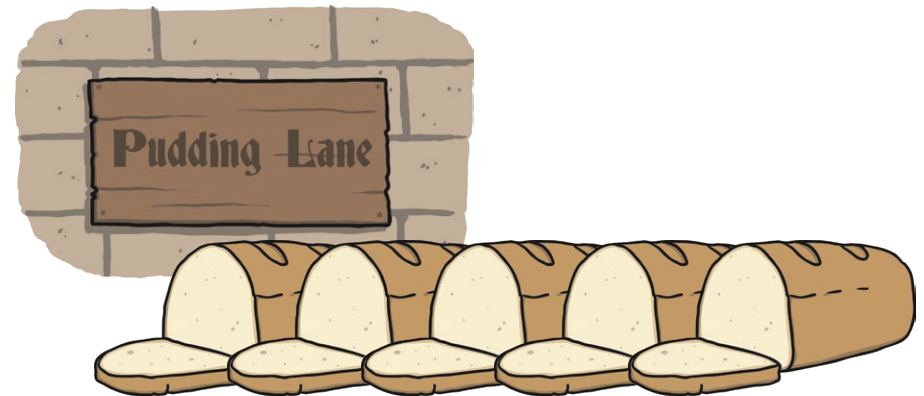

1. Here is some bread at the Pudding Lane bakery.

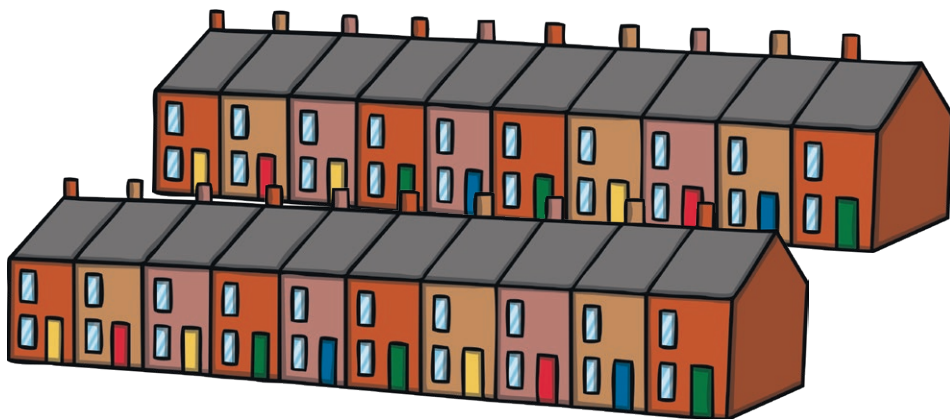
How many more are needed to make 20 altogether?

How many do not have holes?



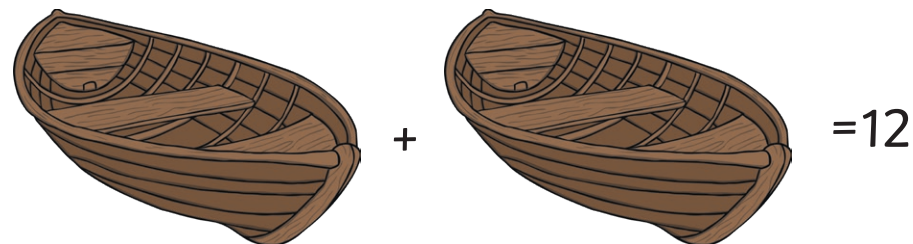

6. Three people loaded two boxes each onto the back of a horse and cart.

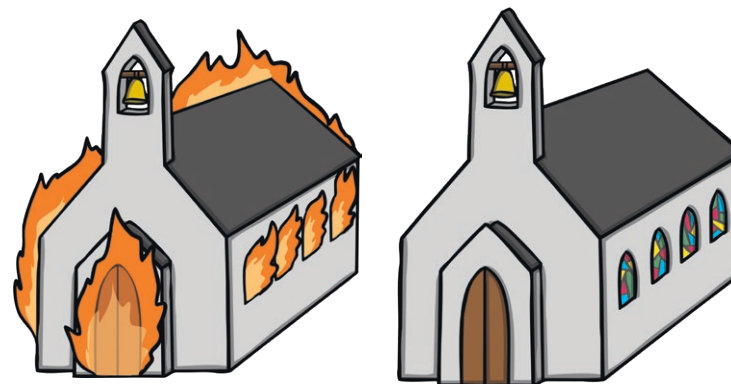
How many boxes were there altogether?

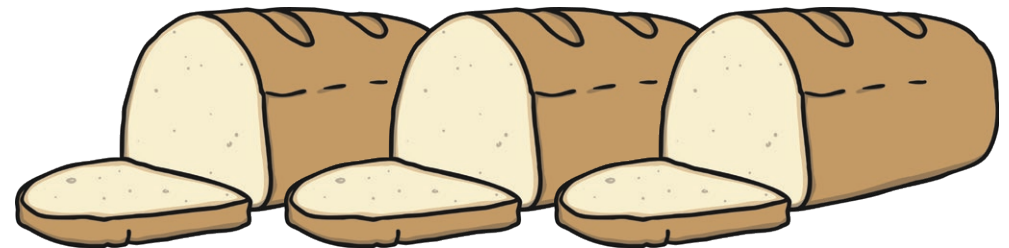
