to Tea

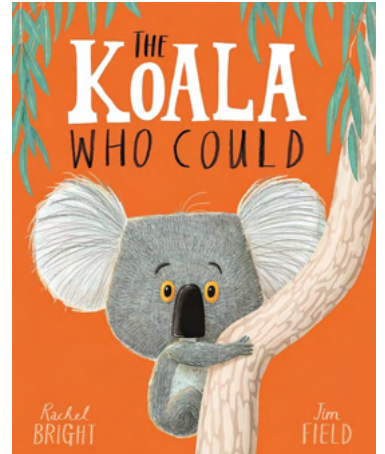

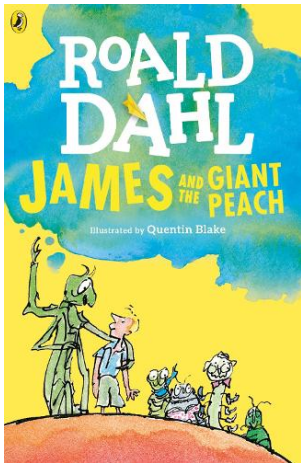
For Class R, we would recommend The Tiger Who Came to Tea. It is a hilarious story with lovely illustrations. We think you would enjoy it!

Class 2



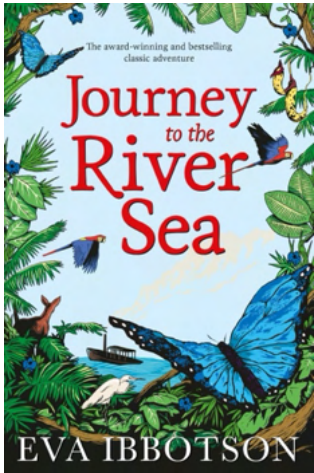
For Class 2, we recommend James and the Giant Peach. It is about an orphan named James, who finds his purpose in a magical, giant peach.

For Class 3, we recommend The Land of Roar. It is a fantasy story about an twins called Arthur and Rose, who experience adventures in 'Roar'.



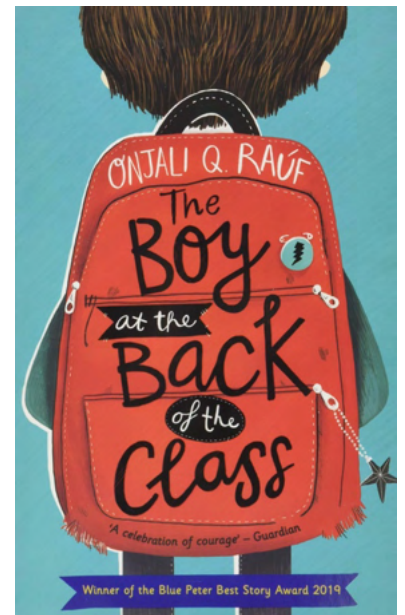
Class 4



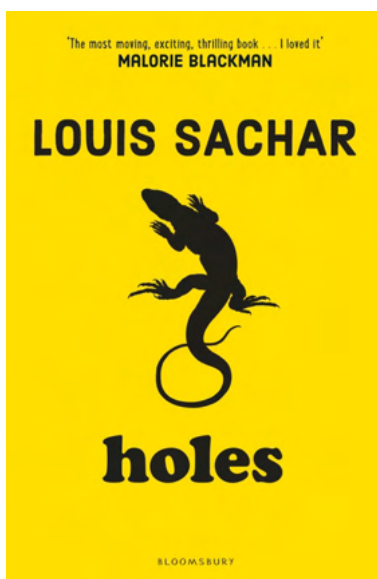
For class 4, we would recommend the Journey to the River Sea. It is about characters who set of on an adventure through the wilderness of Brazil.

Popcorn Balls

3 tablespoons of unsalted butter
190g of milk chocolate
200g of golden syrup
Parchment paper



Recipe

1. Put your popcorn in a bowl and put it to the side.
2. Boil water and put a bowl over the water.
3. Melt the butter and chocolate and add the golden syrup.
4. When it is melted, take the bowl of the water and put the mixture in the popcorn and mix until all of the popcorn is covered.

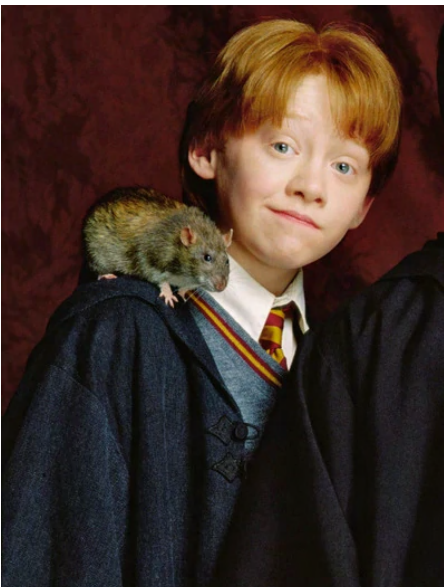
