How to Build the Best Den Ever!

Ever adventured through a forest and wondered how you would build a shelter in case you got lost?

These simple steps will help you build a robust shelter that will (hopefully) keep you warm and dry!

What You Need:

- Tree (1.5 meters tall)
- Logs
- Branches
- Leaves

Reasons to build a forest den:

- Shelter from bad weather
- Develops team building skills
- Helps you engage with nature

Chronological Order

Step 1: find the perfect support

Primarily, find a tall tree - on a flat piece of land - for your central pole (do this carefully to avoid injury).

Ideally the tree will have a strong horizontal branch for you to tie your wall logs to and will be about 1.5 metres tall.



'What you need'

Step 2: source your walls

Next, cautiously source ten slim logs that are precisely 2 metres long to make your walls. Logs that are 10-15 cm thick are great.

Step 3: check the horizontal support

After finding your logs, meticulously analyse the strength of the horizontal branch to make sure it will hold up your walls.

Step 4: get building

Soon after, gently prop your wall logs against your horizontal support branch. Remember to evenly space your logs so that you have room to move inside your den.

Step 5: Waterproof

Later, delicately position your wall logs with the trunks positioned upwards and the branches downwards (this ensures optimum water run-off and will keep you dry and comfortable inside).

Step 6: fill in the gaps

As you begin to finish, thoroughly fill the gaps between your logs with smaller logs and leafy branches for extra cosiness.

Step 7: safety check!

Penultimately, evaluate the sturdiness and general safety of your creation by walking around it and gently pressing on the walls.
