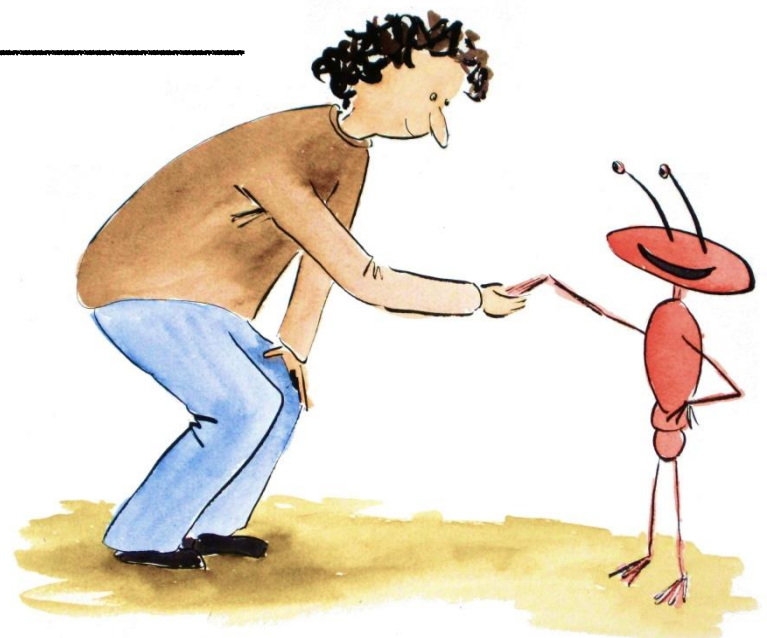

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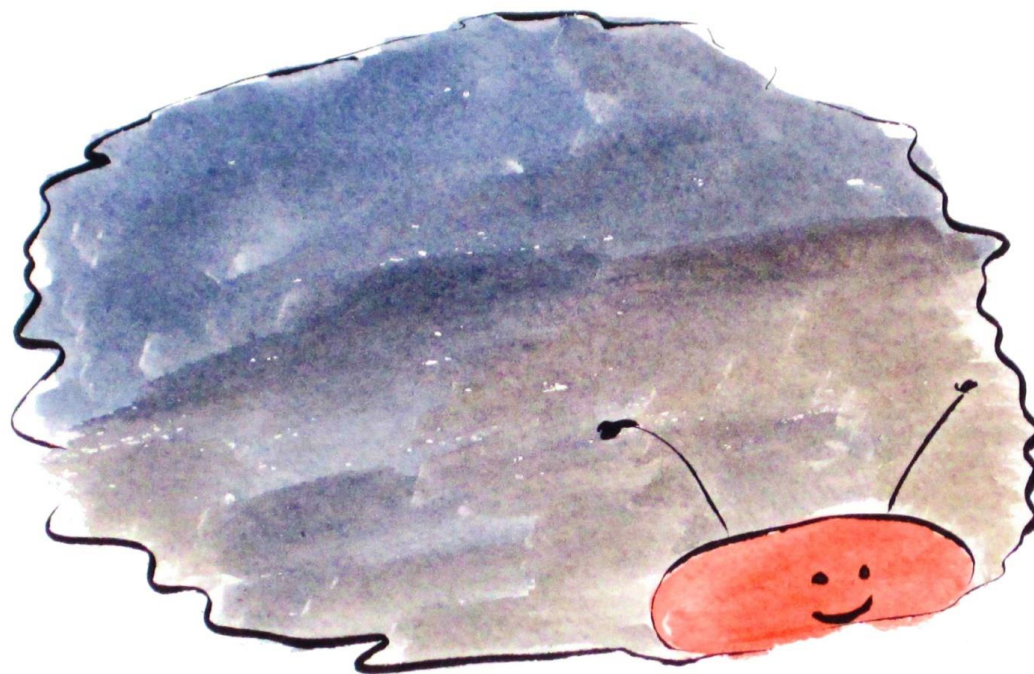

as stars sailed silent by

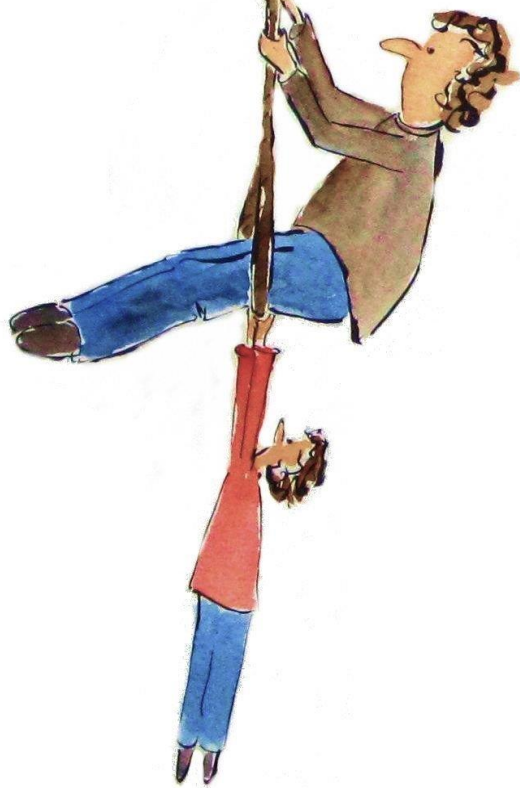
“Shall we use a ladder, Dad? We’ve got one really long.”
