

Create Your Own River Thames Bridges and Sewers Game

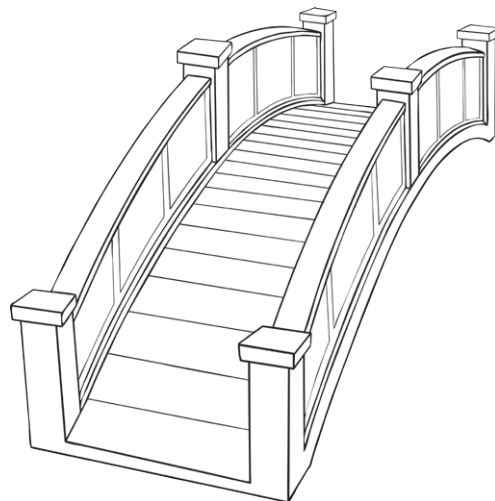
Instructions

This game will be just like a traditional game of Snakes and Ladders - but instead of ladders, you will use bridges and instead of snakes, you will use sewers!

Use the information you have learnt from The River Thames Timeline Cards to help you.

Choose a blank template from the ones available.

1. Choose a blank template from the ones available.
2. If you choose the completely blank template, you will need to draw on your own bridges and sewers.
3. At the bottom of each ladder, fill in the box with a positive fact from the River Thames Timeline Cards that you have learnt about.
4. At the top of each sewer, fill in the box with a negative fact that has happened on the River Thames.
5. If you have a template without numbers, now is the time to fill in the numbers into any blank space. Remember to start from the bottom left-hand corner and zigzag your way up the board until you get to 100 in the top corner.
6. Colour in your board and add illustrations if needed. Often, in traditional Snakes and Ladders games, the squares are alternate colours. Look some up on the Internet to help with your ideas.
7. Use counters and a dice to play the game!
