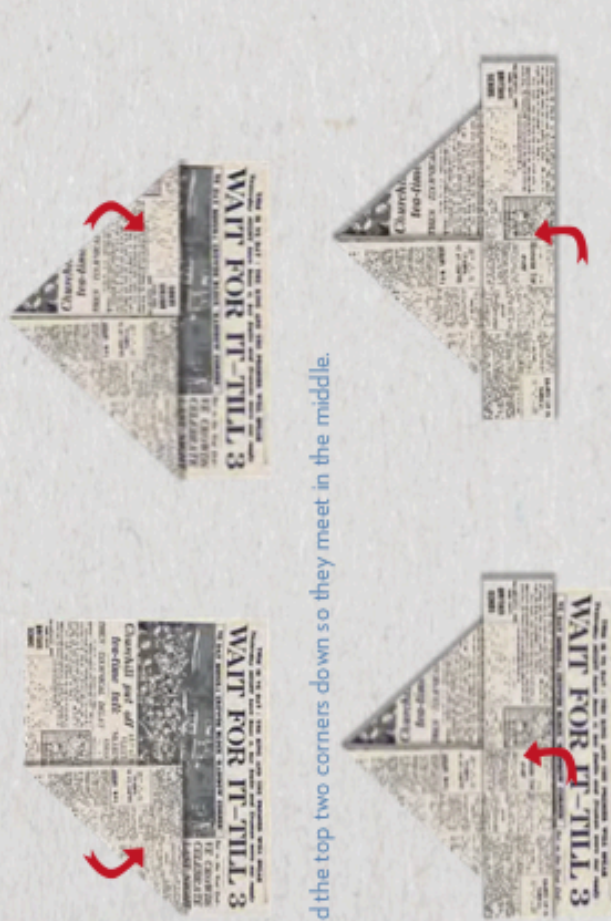


VE DAY DECORATIONS

Using a large newspaper or piece of paper, fold the paper in half.



Fold the top two corners down so they meet in the middle.

Fold the bottom front flap upwards and repeat on the other side.
