Can you help me design a mug to celebrate the NHS? I will give you some tips, but the final design is down to you.

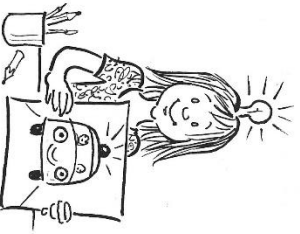

Activity Sheet Three

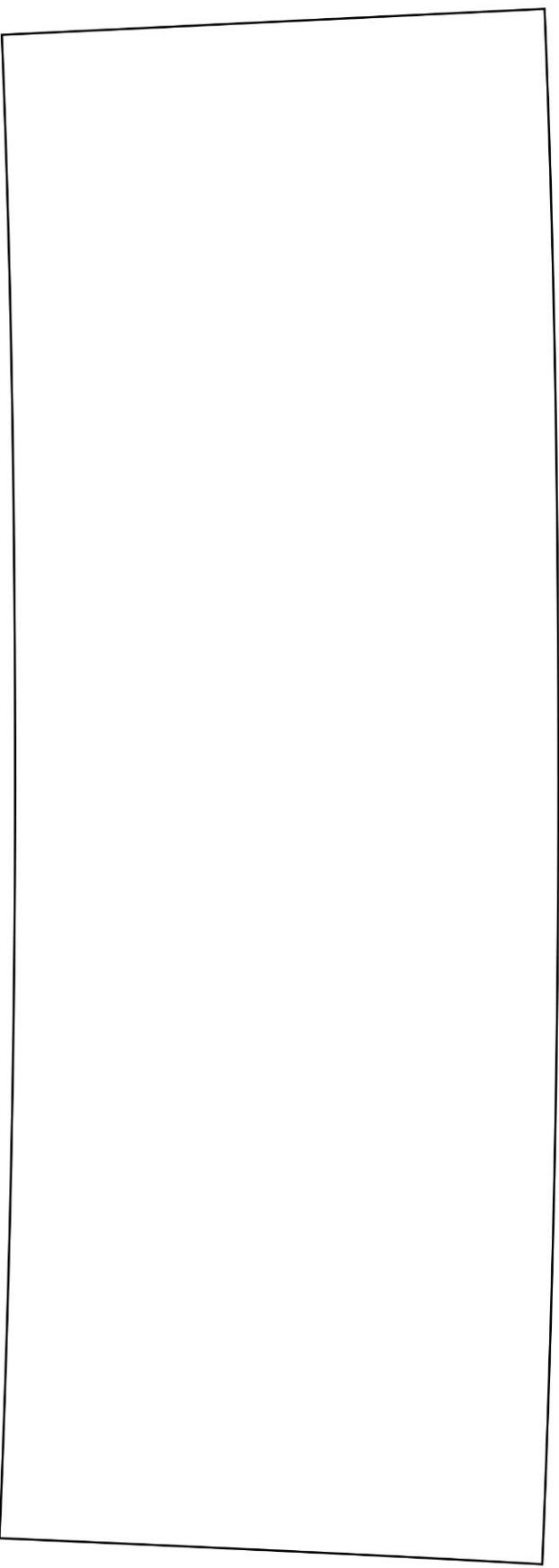
