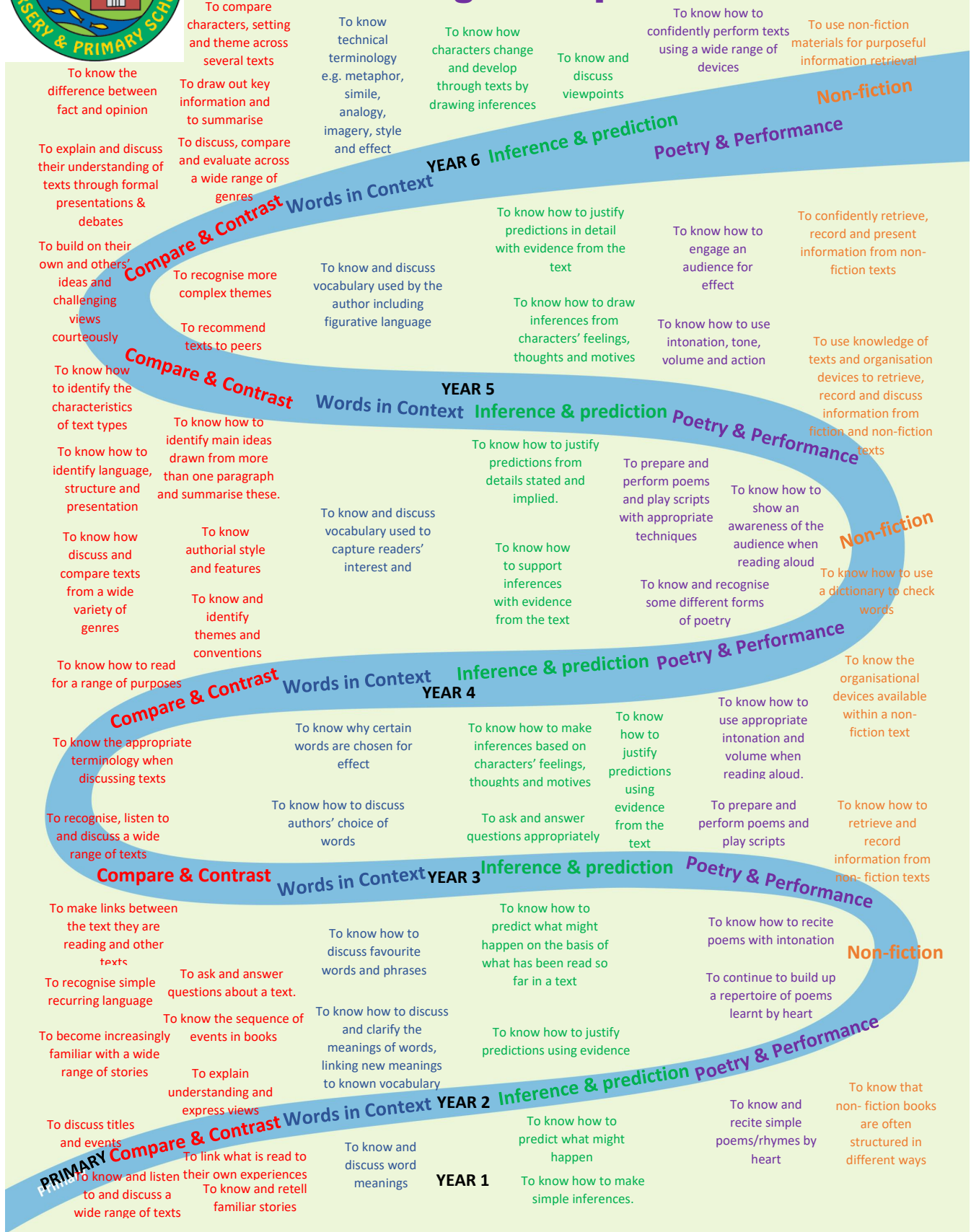

Reading – Word Reading

To develop and apply vocabulary through reading new words

To read all Y5/ Y6 exception words, discussing the unusual correspondences

To read familiar words accurately and fluently with intonation and expression

To read fluently with full knowledge of all strategies taught

To decode any unfamiliar words with increasing speed and skill

To apply their growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes/ word endings.

To recognise the meaning of words through contextual cues.

To apply knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes/word endings to read aloud fluently

To attempt to decode any unfamiliar words with increasing speed and skill.

Use known vocabulary to make sense of a text

To use their phonic knowledge to decode quickly and accurately

To accurately read most words of two or more syllables

To learn words with suffixes

To read Y1 and Y2 common exception words, noting unusual correspondences

To read familiar words accurately and fluently

To read aloud books, sounding out unfamiliar words

To reread books to build up fluency

To read words with contractions

To blend sounds in unfamiliar words

Correcting inaccuracies

To show understanding by drawing on what is already known or on the background

To apply phonic knowledge and skills

To read words containing taught GPCs.

To read Y1 common exception words

To check that a text makes sense and to self- correct
