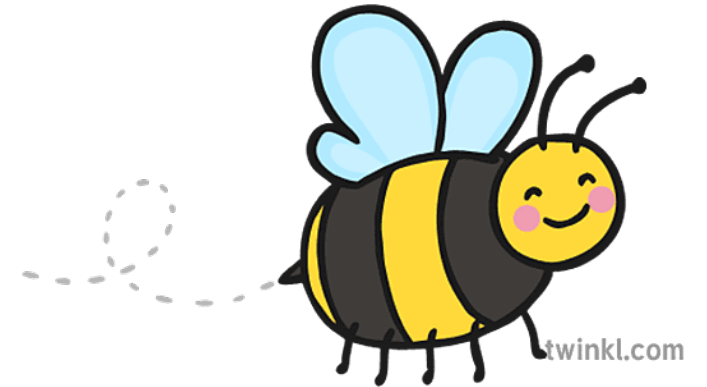

- Fine if I have an idea to base it on



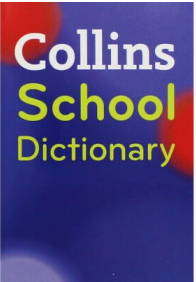
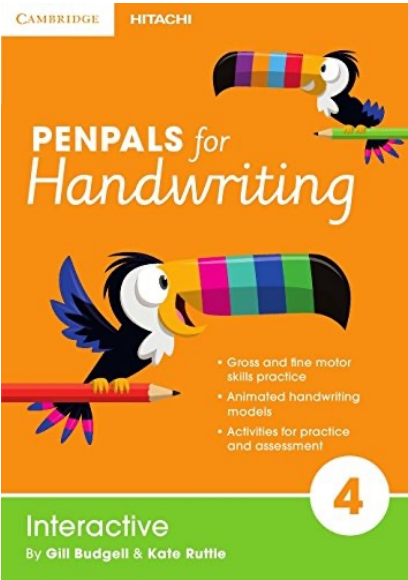
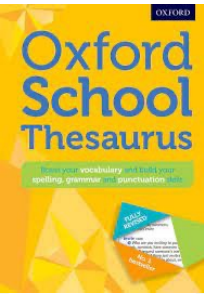
How does your writing help you in other parts of your day?
