They were pleased to receive their Blue Peter Green Badges this week!

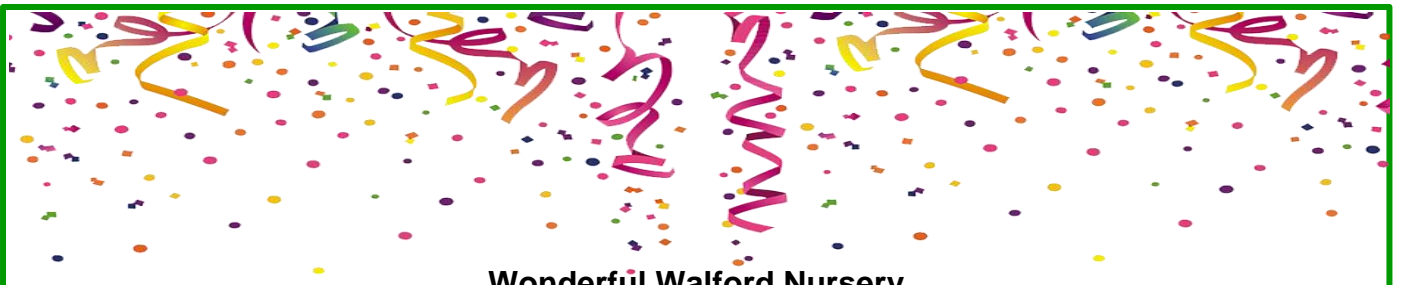
